

ASBESTOS MANAGEMENT PLAN NOTIFICATION

2022 – 2023 School Year

In maintaining compliance with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) and 40 CFR Part 763 Subpart E, the district is required to perform re-inspections of the asbestos materials every three years by a New York State certified inspector. Inspection findings are located in the asbestos management plan and are on file in the maintenance office. Six-month visual surveillance inspections are also performed during the school year by qualified individuals and are on file in the asbestos management plan. All identified asbestos materials in school buildings remain in good condition and are monitored as recommended by EPA guidelines.

In the event that a planned response action becomes necessary, notification will be posted ten days prior to such action, or in the case of an emergency, notice will be posted immediately and appropriate notification will be issued.
