## PES Kindergarten Classroom Supplies

**\*\* Please be sure the following items are labeled with your child's name, classroom, and teacher's name. Please print so that your child will be able to identify their items. \*\***

- A backpack\*
- A lunch box & water bottle\* - It is highly encouraged that Kindergarteners bring their lunch and drink for the first two weeks of school.
- A smock for art class\* - an old button up or t-shirt of yours works great for this!
- Headphones\* - place in a gallon sized Ziploc bag labeled with your child's name. No ear buds please.
- 1 inch binder\* - any color with clear plastic "pouch" on cover is recommended. Please label with your child's name on the INSIDE of the binder.
- A change of clothes\* - including pants, shirt, socks, and underwear. Please place clothes in a gallon sized Ziploc bag, labeled with your child's name.

The following items are general classroom supplies and **DO NOT** require you to label them:

- 10 pack jumbo, CLASSIC colors Crayola Markers
- Pair of blunt tip scissors – 5" Fiskars brand recommended
- Zippered, CLEAR/SEE THROUGH pencil pouch with binder rings (for take home folder)

The Poestenkill PTA will be providing classrooms with consumable items. Pencils, tissues, dry erase markers etc.

In September, when you and your child come to school to meet their teacher, please bring your child's supplies. Your child will need to bring their backpack, lunch box, water bottle, and plastic pocket folder every day beginning the first full day of school. Thanks!
