

Lindsey Haff-Phelan '00

Lindsey graduated from Averill Park High School in 2000. She then attended Hudson Valley Community College and Excelsior College and graduated in 2008 with a degree in business. She is currently employed by CapCom Federal Credit Union as a Quality Control Analyst. Lindsey and her husband Michael along with their boys Alex, Ryan, Samuel and Liam reside in Poestenkill.

At Averill Park Lindsey competed for four years in softball, three years in basketball and one year in volleyball. Most notably in softball her individual accolades for her career include a 41-5 pitching record, 311 innings pitched, 405 strikeouts, .063 ERA, 1 perfect game, 3 no-hitters, 13 one-hitters, 6 two-hitters, 8 three-hitters, 3 time Colonial

Council MVP runner-up, 1 time Colonial Council MVP, 2 time all-area 2nd team, 2 time all-area 1st team, Class B all-state 3rd team and Class A all-state 4th team.

During Lindsey's career her team accomplishments include four straight Colonial Council championships and 57 consecutive Colonial Council wins. Lindsey was a dominant pitching force, not only in the Colonial Council but in all of Section 2 for four years.







Christopher Mazzeo '91

Christopher is a 1991 graduate of Averill Park High School. He then attended Southern Vermont College where he earned a degree in social work in 1996. Christopher resides in Averill Park with his wife Jodi, and their children Hannah, Ty and Brady.

At Averill Park Chris was a three-sport athlete. He played soccer and basketball for three years and baseball for four years. In soccer Christopher scored 68 career goals. He was the team MVP as a junior and senior, the MVP of the Patroon Conference as a senior and a Section 2 1st team all-star. In basketball he was a 1st team Patroon Conference all-star as a junior and the Patroon Conference MVP as a senior. Christopher was

also a Times Union Small School 1st team all-star as well as a Channel 6 all-star. In his career he scored 1,385 points and averaged 29.7 points/game as a senior. In baseball Christopher had a .407 career batting average and in his senior year he was named the team MVP and a Patroon Conference all-star.

Christopher went on to play soccer, basketball and baseball at Southern Vermont College. He came back to Averill Park to coach varsity boys soccer, freshman girls basketball and varsity softball. He has also coached soccer, basketball and baseball in community youth programs for many years.







Mary Anne Schiermeyer '76 (deceased)

Mary Anne is a 1976 graduate of Averill Park High School. She then attended Hudson Valley Community College for two years and competed on both the basketball and softball teams. She continued her education and played Division I basketball at Memphis State University. Mary Anne then returned to the Capital District and finished her physical education degree at Russell Sage College. She worked as a security guard at Regis College and also was an assistant coach at RPI for both basketball and softball.

At Averill Park Mary Anne was a five-sport athlete. She played field hockey, volleyball and basketball for four years and softball and outdoor

track & field for two years. During her career her teams won league championships in volleyball (1974), basketball (1975, 1976) and softball (1974). In outdoor track & field Mary Anne was the high jump record holder at Averill Park for many years.

Mary Anne was the first female student-athlete from Averill park to receive a Division I scholarship. Her 1979-80 basketball team at Memphis State University was the first to play in the Metro Conference. This team earned the #1 seed for the conference tournament with an overall record of 19-12.







1990 Girls Cross Country Team

The 1990 girls cross country team was the first team in Averill Park history to win a state championship. Deborah Springer '91 (co-captain), Kate Cronk '92 (co-captain), Rebecca Pollock Seidenstein '95, Tamica Blowers Kenyon '92, Amy Villagio '92 and Jessica Shea Grieves '92 comprised the

team coached by Mark Mindel.

This team won every invitational that they were entered in during season including the Manhattan Invitational, Grout Invitational, Guilderland Invitational, Troy Invitational, Johnstown Invitational, Gloversville Invitational and the Averill Park Invitational. The team went 8-0 in the Patroon Conference, ran their winning streak to 33 consecutive meets in the Patroon Conference and captured their 5th straight Patroon Conference Championship. The team won their 2nd straight Section 2 Class B championship and went on to win the NYSPHSAA Class B championship.

Cronk, Springer, Pollock Seidenstein, Blowers Kenyon, Villagio and Shea Grieves were named Patroon Conference all-stars. Springer, Pollock Seidenstein and Cronk who were named NYS all-stars. Springer, Cronk, Pollock Seidenstein and Blowers Kenyon were named Troy Record all-stars.






