Who Can Vote

- 18 years old by June 9, 2020
- · Registered to vote
- Live within the Averill Park CSD boundaries for at least 30 days prior to June 9, 2020.
- Not otherwise disqualified to register for or vote at an election in accordance with the provisions of Section 5-106 of the election law

How You Can Vote

In the interest of public safety due to the COVID-19 pandemic, voting this year will take place using absentee ballots only, per Governor Cuomo's Executive Order. Every eligible voter will receive an absentee ballot and a postage paid return envelope in the mail.

Poll Registration

Qualified voters on the most recent years' poll lists will be automatically sent an absentee ballot. Anyone who meets the definition of a "qualified voter," but does not believe he/she will be on the School District's poll list, which contains the names of residents who voted in recent years' elections, please contact Yvonne Phillips, District Clerk, at phillipsy@apcsd.org as soon as possible to ensure timely receipt of an absentee ballot.
