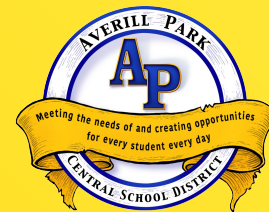


Federal Stimulus Planning

CRRSA and ARP Funding





Federal Stimulus Aid

- \$12 billion to NY schools (in two funded sources: ARP and CRRSA)
- Projected to receive \$4.64 million over the next four years
- Federally granted -- separate from general fund
- Some restrictions in how funding can be used: learning loss, summer programs, afterschool programming
- Careful consideration of how we use this funding (ongoing versus one-time costs)



Key Dates

- June 2021: Public comment period
- July 1, 2021: Plan for ARP funding (\$2.0 million) must be posted on district website
- July 15, 2021: Application for CRRSA (\$2.6 million) submitted to NYSED
- September 30, 2023: CRRSA funds expended
- September 30, 2024: ARP funds expended



Planning Priorities

- Supporting academic growth
- Coordinating social-emotional learning efforts across district
- Promoting effective use of technology in the classroom
- Developing capacity of our instructional staff
- Returning from COVID logistics



Supporting academic growth

- Adding additional AIS teacher at each elementary and middle school
- Offering summer programs to students in K-12
- Enhanced afterschool programs (6-8)
- New literacy curriculum materials at K-5



Coordinating social-emotional learning efforts across district

- Creation of two K-12 SEL positions
 - Direction and coordination for the effective implementation of the district's social and emotional learning initiative
 - Build and deepen a positive school climate and culture by training teachers and leadership teams
 - Focus on the core understanding of the five core competencies: Self-Awareness, Self-Management, Social Awareness, Relationships Skills, and Responsible Decision making.



Promoting effective use of technology in the classroom

- Update classroom display devices that are no longer supported by vendor
- Focus on devices that allow for “anywhere” teaching and presenting in the classroom



Developing capacity of our instructional staff

- More embedded professional development opportunities for teachers
 - Science of Reading
 - Professional Learning Communities
 - Next Generation Science Standards
- Teaching and Learning Cabinet



Returning from COVID logistics

- Emptying trailers
- Tents for outdoor activities/events
- Additional PPE supplies and equipment
- Furniture to support current guidelines
 - Better positioned for flexible classroom models
