- Served with distinction in the athletic program

## ● Team (not eligible until 2022)

- Accomplishment was 10 years ago or more
- Has made unique athletic accomplishments

## ● Contributor

- Went above and beyond for the athletes at Averill Park

## Number of Inductees

The inaugural Class of 2018 and the Class of 2019 shall include no more than a total of 13 inductees each. The Class of 2020 and the Class of 2021 shall include no more than a total of 10 inductees. Future classes will not exceed seven inductees. Teams are separate and are not eligible for induction until 2022.

"Coach" Earl Retlaff



### **Paula “Miss Mann” Maniscalco (deceased)**

Paula Maniscalco was a pioneer at the inception of girls interscholastic athletics at Averill Park High School. Miss Mann, as she was known, emerged on the scene in the fall of 1970. It was at this time that Paula fought for and started girls varsity sports at Averill Park. She taught Physical Education and Health at Averill Park High School and coached most of the inaugural teams after the implementation of Title IX. Miss Mann graduated from Colonie High

School in 1965. She then attended the State University College at Brockport and received a Bachelor of Science degree in 1970. Paula went on to complete her graduate studies at Ithaca College between 1972 and 1975.

During the decade of Paula’s service at Averill Park she coached field hockey, girls volleyball, girls basketball, softball, and girls outdoor track & field, all at the varsity level. Her teams were well coached and disciplined, and performed at a very high level of competition. As a result, Paula’s teams compiled league titles in field hockey, volleyball, basketball, and softball. Paula also coached at the collegiate level, leading the field hockey team for RPI in 1979.

As an athlete Paula lettered in field hockey, volleyball, basketball and softball at Brockport. While in the Rochester area, Paula became a state certified official in field hockey, girls volleyball, and girls basketball. She was also part of the regional tryout for the United States field hockey team in 1970.

In the fall of 1980 Paula’s focus shifted from education to medicine. She attended Hudson Valley Community College where she received an Associate’s Degree in Applied Sciences in 1982. Paula became a Registered Physician’s Assistant certified by the State of New York in 1982. She went on to be a Physician’s Assistant in surgery from 1982 until 2012 at Memorial Hospital in Albany.

Paula Maniscalco was an incredible person who had an immeasurable impact on many lives. The importance of her legacy still resonates in our programs today. We would not be where we are without Paula’s courage to take on the challenge of the time.





## **“Coach” Earl Retzlaff**

For more than 50 years Coach Retzlaff has been around Averill Park athletic competitions. Coach Retzlaff was employed by the Averill Park Central School District as an elementary Physical Education teacher and he also was a varsity football assistant coach, boys junior varsity basketball head coach, and varsity baseball head coach. Earl and his wife Susan settled in Averill Park along with their children Barbra

and Brian. After graduating from Catholic High in 1949 Coach Retzlaff served his country in the military from 1952-1954. He then attended Ithaca College where he earned his Bachelor and Master of Science degrees in Physical Education and Health.

As the varsity baseball coach he amassed 310 victories over 26 years and has the most wins of any baseball coach in Averill park history. This also places him 26th in Section 2 history in career wins. He was named Coach of the Year numerous times and his teams went deep into sectional competition under his guidance. Coach Retzlaff also served as the Section 2 Class B Baseball Chairman for eight years.

Beyond the boundaries of Averill Park, Coach Retzlaff served as a baseball instructor at the SUNY Albany Baseball Camp for 22 years. He also worked at Hudson Valley Community College as an assistant baseball coach and in the Physical Education Department after he retired from Averill Park in 1986. Coach Retzlaff is still an ardent supporter of Averill Park athletics and can be found in attendance at many athletic contests.





## Steven Allard '83

Steven is a 1983 graduate of Averill Park High School. He then went on to attend the University of Massachusetts and received a degree in Sport Management in 1987. Steven resides in Averill Park with his wife Christine and son Gregory. He is currently employed at RPI as the Director of Campus Recreation, Mueller Center, and Club Sports.

At Averill Park Steven played four years of baseball, recording 24 wins and 287 strikeouts as a pitcher.

He also threw 11 complete games and four no-hitters. He was all-league (1981-83), all-area 1st Team (1982-83), and all-state (1982-83). Steven was a USA National All-American in 1983 as well as one of 63 seniors selected to play in the National Festival Baseball Tournament. Steven also was a three year starter on the basketball team and scored 701 career points. He was named all-league in 1983.

Steven earned a Division I scholarship to pitch at UMass and was named Pitcher of the Week twice in his sophomore season. During that season he struck out 11 batters and only gave up one hit in a game vs. Providence College. Steven tried out for the 1994 USA Olympic team.

After college Steven coached baseball at RPI and was named the National Assistant Pitching Coach of the Year in 2002. He is currently an associate scout for the Philadelphia Phillies.





## **Ken Gunderman '83**

Ken graduated from Averill Park High School in 1983. He went on to attend Hudson Valley Community College and graduated in 1986 with an Associate's degree in Liberal Arts. Ken, his fiancée Cathy Pastore, and stepchildren Mike and Jessica reside in Averill Park. Ken is currently employed by Rifenburg Construction where he has been a foreman for 34 years.

While at Averill Park Ken played four years of basketball and three years of football and baseball. Ken is the all-time leading scorer in Averill Park boys basketball history. He was named the team MVP in 1982 and 1983. Ken was named all-area 1st team in 1983. In football Ken was named all-league as a kick returner in 1980 and all-league as a running back in 1981. Ken is also a recipient of Averill Park's highest senior athletic honor, the Al DeShaw Award.

At Hudson Valley Community College Ken played two years of basketball. He was 3rd in the region, shooting 87% from the foul line, and was also a member of a Mountain Valley Conference championship team.

Ken has spent much of his adult life coaching youth sports and giving back to his community. Currently he is the boys varsity basketball assistant coach at LaSalle Institute. He is also a member of the Connie Mack Baseball Hall of Fame.





## **Suzanne Ernst Howell '96**

Suzanne is a 1996 graduate of Averill Park High School. She then attended the University of North Florida where she graduated in 1999 with a degree in Health Science. Suzanne is employed by the Virginia Bariatric Surgery Center as a registered dietician. She currently resides in Round Hill, Virginia with her husband Randall and their two daughters, Olivia and Abigail.

As an athlete at Averill Park Suzanne competed for four years in cross country, indoor track & field, and outdoor track & field. At the Section 2 Class B Cross Country Championships Suzanne placed 4th in 1994 and was the runner-up in 1995. She placed 10th in 1994 and 13th in 1995 at the NYSPHSAA Class B Championships. She was a member and captain of three Colonial Council Conference championship teams and three Section 2 Class B championship teams (1993-95), two NYSPHSAA Class B runner-up teams (1993-94) and a NYSPHSAA Class B championship team (1995). In outdoor track & field Suzanne was the 1996 NYSPHSAA Class B 3000m champion posting a winning time of 10:17.5. She was also the National 5K Outdoor Track Champion and named an All-American in 1996.

While at the University of North Florida Suzanne was named an All-American in outdoor track & field in 1996 and 1997. In 1997 she was also named Most Outstanding in cross country for the Peach Belt Conference.

After a competitive high school and collegiate career Suzanne has completed two marathons and a few "ultras". She continues to run the Appalachian Trail for pleasure and enjoys the therapy that it provides.





## Mollie DeFrancesco Turner '98

Mollie graduated from Averill Park High School in 1998. She continued her education at James Madison University where she received a Bachelor of Science degree in Kinesiology in 2003 and a Master of Science degree in Exercise Physiology in 2006. Mollie currently resides in Chesapeake, Virginia with her husband Peter and their two daughters, Emmaline and Natalie. She is a teacher for the Chesapeake Public Schools.

While attending Averill Park Mollie competed in outdoor track & field for four years, cross country for three years, and indoor track & field for two years. Mollie was the first female at Averill Park to compete in the steeplechase and was the Rensselaer County champion in 1998. She was a member and captain of three Colonial Council cross country championship teams (1995-97), two Section 2 Class B championship teams (1995-96), and two NYSPHSAA Class B championship teams (1995-96).

While participating in all three sports at Division I James Madison as a walk on, Mollie was the first James Madison student-athlete to earn three All-American honors in the same year. In 2001 and 2002 Mollie was the Colonial Athletic Association individual cross country champion. Her team won the championship both of those years, as well as in 2000. In 2001 she was a Colonial Athletic Association champion and a 10th place finisher at the USA Track & Field Championships in the 3,000m steeplechase. In 2002 she was a Colonial Athletic Association champion and won the 3,000m steeplechase at the POWERade North America, Central America, and Caribbean Under 25 Championships, placed fourth in the 3,000m steeplechase at the NCAA Outdoor Track & Field Championships and sixth in the 5,000m run at the NCAA Indoor Track & Field Championships.

Mollie was named the 2002 Mondo/US Track Coaches Association Southeast Region Athlete of the Year and the Colonial Athletic Association Track & Field Athlete of the Year. In 2002 and 2003 Mollie was named the James Madison Female Athlete of the Year.

At the time of her graduation from James Madison Mollie held school records in the 3,000m steeplechase (9:56.07), 5,000m run (16:03.97), and the 5,000m indoor run (16:22.64). She has since been named to the Colonial Athletic Association Silver Anniversary Team and was inducted into the James Madison University Athletic Hall of Fame in November of 2015.

Mollie continues to run competitively. She has won the HMRRC Grand Prix and was the runner-up in 2016 at the USATF Adirondack Grand Prix. She is still recording personal bests, including the half marathon (1:18:59) and marathon (2:53.32) in 2017.





## Suzie Snyder '00

Suzie is a 2000 graduate of Averill Park High School. Upon graduation Suzie attended Springfield College where she majored in Exercise Science and received her undergraduate degree in 2004 and her graduate degree in 2006. She currently resides in Reno, Nevada and is self-employed as a strength & conditioning coach. Suzie is also a professional triathlete and mountain biker.

As an athlete at Averill Park Suzie competed for four years in cross country, indoor track & field, and outdoor track & field. In the pole vault Suzie was the 1998 Section 2 Outdoor Track & Field champion and placed third in Class A at the NYSPHSAA Outdoor Track and Field Championships. In 1999 the pole vault was contested for the first time at the NYSPHSAA Indoor Track & Field Championships and Suzie won the inaugural state championship and became the meet record holder at 10'0". At the 1999 NYSPHSAA Outdoor Track & Field Championships Suzie placed fourth in Class A. She also placed fourth in the 2000 NYSPHSAA Indoor Track & Field Championships. Suzie was part of the cross country team in 1996 that won the Colonial Council championship, Section 2 Class B championship and the NYSPHSAA Class B championship.

Suzie continued to compete in all three sports in college. She is the school record holder in the pole vault at Springfield and was a three-time Division III All-New England Team member in track & field.

Suzie is an accomplished triathlete and mountain biker. Suzie won the 2012, 2016, and 2018 Xterra Off-Road Triathlon National Championship, Elite. She was also the 2016 and 2017 Xterra Pan Am Tour Champion as well as the 2016 US Masters Swimming Open Water National Champion. Suzie was named the USA Triathlon Off-Road Athlete of the Year in 2016 and 2017.





## **Abby Jackson '04**

Abby graduated from Averill Park High School in 2004. After graduation she attended Yale University where she received a degree in Political Science in 2008. Abby is employed by Business Insider as a reporter. She now lives in Jersey City, New Jersey with her husband Dominick.

While attending Averill Park Abby competed in both indoor track & field and outdoor track & field for five years as a sprinter. In 2002 she placed fifth and in 2003 she placed seventh in the 300m dash at the NYSPHSAA Indoor Track & Field Championships. In outdoor track & field Abby was the 2002 Section 2 Class A champion in the 400m dash and went on to place sixth at the NYSPHSAA Championships. Abby also advanced to the 2003 NYSPHSAA Outdoor Track & Field Championships. In indoor track & field Abby still holds the Averill Park school record in the 300m dash with a time of 41.0 and is a part of the 800m relay team that holds the school record. Abby also holds the school record for the 400m dash in outdoor track & field with a time of 57.4.

While attending Yale Abby was a member of the track & field team for two years.





## Jared Morine '06

Jared graduated from Averill Park High School in 2006. He then attended Columbia University and earned a degree in Political Science in 2010. Jared currently resides in Los Angeles, California and is pursuing his MBA at the UCLA Anderson School of Management.

As an athlete at Averill Park Jared played football, basketball, and baseball. During his senior year he played in three Section 2 Class A championships games. As the Section 2 Class A Division I Player of the Year he led the football team to the Section 2 Class A championship game. Jared was also named an all-area All-Purpose Player by the Times Union, all-area Defensive Back by the Troy Record, and third team all-state. On the basketball court Jared led his team to a Section 2 Class A title, a NYSPHSAA Class A regional championship, and to the NYSPHSAA Final Four. He was named a Suburban Council all-star, the Section 2 Class A Tournament MVP, and a NYSPHSAA Class A All-Tournament team member. Jared then captained the baseball team to the Section 2 Class A championship game in the spring.

In college Jared played four years of football at Columbia University. He received the Lou Little Coaches' Most Improved Award in 2009. He was then named a NFF Hampshire Honor Society member in 2010. Jared is currently tied for the most interceptions returned for a touchdown in Columbia University history in both a single season and for a career.
