Andrew is a 1972 graduate of Averill Park High School. After graduation he attended Loyola College of Montreal and then Hudson Valley Community College where he graduated with an Associate of Arts in 1974. In outdoor track & field Andrew was the team MVP in 1971 and 1972 and won the conference championship in the 400m dash and the mile relay.

At Loyola College of Montreal Andrew competed in the basketball Final Four of Canada in 1973. Upon returning to Hudson Valley Community College he played basketball and golf and placed 5th in the golf regionals in 1974.

Andrew is a member of the Colorado Education Association Hall of Fame. He has coached basketball, soccer and track & field at Adams City Middle School. Andrew has also been a mentor in the University of Colorado teacher preparation program.
