Request for overnight trip to Providence Rhode Island to participate in the Ocean State Invitational for Cross Country Team

- 1) Educational Purpose: Students will be competing against athletes from a variety of northeastern states.
- 2) Dates: Friday September 27-Saturday September 28, 2019
- 3) Itinerary:

Friday September 27

12:30 departure

3:30 arrival at Goddard State Park

3:30-5 run the course

5:30-6 Hotel check in

or

5:30-7 harbor ride (waiting to hear for an evening time)

6-10 supervised activity including dinner

or

7:30-10 supervised activity including dinner

Saturday September 28

8:15 am departure for Invitational

9:50-12 pm races (exact race times are determined closer to the date of invitational depending on the size of the schools entered

1:00- awards ceremony

1:30 – departure to Newport RI

3:30 - Harbor Tour of Newport Harbor and Narragansett Bay

9pm- Arrival at Averill Park

- 4) # of Students: 7 varsity girls, 7 Varsity Boys, 5-7 JV Boys, 5-7 JV girls (total 24-28 athletes)
- 5) Nature: District students grades 8-12
- 6) Costs:
 - a) Hotel: Hampton Inn Warwick/Providence airport \$115 a night based on 3-4 person occupancy
 - b) Food: \$50-2 lunches, 2 dinners
 - c) Harbor Tour: \$35
 - d) Transportation: \$30
 - e) Individual Breakdown: approximately: \$150

- 7) Teacher in Charge: Wendy Glunk, Laurence Quinn
- 8) Travel Agency/Discounts: Discounted block room rate for hotel, group rate for habor tour
- 9) Chaperones: Wendy Glunk, Larry Quinn
- 10) Liability: health insurance first covered by student/chaperone, then district as it would be normally
- 11) Insurance: Blue Cards will be taken with students information
- 12) Fundraising: Car Wash/Bake Sale, Gold Cards
- 13) Scholarships: request from the booster club for those students needing assistance
- 14) Refund Disbursements: full refunds given if no penalties apply
- 15) School Equipment: School uniforms, team tent and chronometer
