CSED week is an annual worldwide celebration of computer science which takes place each December. These controllers connect to a computer and help students understand how easy and fun coding can be. This year, we borrowed MakeyMakeys from TechValley High School during Computer Science Education Week and they proved to be very popular with our students.

We are also requesting a Medium Hummingbird Bit Classroom Bundle (Medium Hummingbird Bit Classroom Bundle: http://tiny.cc/85r5kz) and 10 additional micro:bits (BBC254862 Micro Bit: go: http://tiny.cc/w9r5kz) These microcontrollers are easily programmed and connected to various sensors, lights, buzzers etc. to create a wide variety digital projects cardboard robots and digital signs.

Every student is a thinker and a maker and having this equipment will aid students in bringing their ideas to life. It is important for students to be exposed to computing in the virtual world, as well as to computing in the physical world.

Planned activities: This requested equipment will be used in Coding Club, Robotics, and Tech classes, but it can also be used in Math, Science, Art and Social Studies. We will share this equipment with the whole school. As its use expands, there are curricular connections to computer science that can be made in virtually every discipline.

Mr. Hansen and Mrs. Ekstrom are the principal staff and will facilitate and oversee the use of the equipment.

Goals: To teach computer science skills, coding and help students understand how a computer works, as well as use the equipment in interdisciplinary projects.
