<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Ibuprofen, Motrin, Advil</b> fever, pain, headache, menstrual cramps	<b>Q4-6hrs PRN during the school day</b> <b>Liquid or Chewable:</b> 24–35 lbs: 5 mL OR 1 tab, 36–47 lbs: 7.5 mL OR 1.5 tabs, 48–59 lbs: 10 mL OR 2 tabs, 60–71 lbs: 12.5 mL or 2.5 tabs, 72-95 lbs 15ml OR 3 tabs <b>Tablets:</b> 1 tab- 200mg, 2 tabs- 400mg
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Benadryl (diphenhydramineHCL/antihistamine)</b> allergy symptoms-hives <b>1 time dose-</b> <b>Parents will be contacted before administering the dose.</b>	<b>Liquid:12.5/5mls:</b> 6-11 y.o 5-10mls, <b>Chewable: 12.5mg/tab:</b> 6-11 y.o 12.5-25mg- 1-2 tabs, >12 y.o. 25-50mg- 2-4 tabs <b>Pills: 25mg/tab:</b> 6-12 y.o 1 tab, > 12 y.o 1-2 tab
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Caladryl/Calmine/Benadryl cream:</b> for inflamed skin, skin rash from poison ivy, bug bites	Topical use for inflamed skin during school day 1-2
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Bacitracin/Neosporin/antibiotic Ointment:</b> for infected skin lesions/wounds	Topical use for infected skin/wounds during the school day
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Hydrocortisone cream 0.5 to 1.0%:</b> For topical use for poison ivy, sunburn, and/or atopic dermatitis on skin:	Topical use for inflamed skin during: apply up to 2 times during the school day.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Skin lotion/Vaseline/ Petroleum jelly:</b> For cracked skin, dry skin	Topical use for dry skin during the school day: apply to the affected area as needed during the school day. Vaseline can be used to protect minor cuts/burns.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Sting relief/bite swabs: (Benzocaine wipes/swabs)</b> Pain and itching associated with but bites.	Topical use for bug bites: may be used on the affected area up to 4 times per day.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Cough drops/lozenges:</b>	For sore/scratchy throat, cough: 1 lozenge Q2H during the school day.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>TUMS chewable:</b> for stomach upset, acid indigestion, heartburn, sour stomach,	12 years and older- 2-4 tabs as needed during school day
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Lubricating Eye drops:</b> Relief of burning, irritation, discomfort due to dryness of the eyes or exposure to wind, sun, or allergies	1-2 drops in eyes, PRN during the school day
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Chapstick:</b> For dry/chapped lips	Apply to the affected area as needed during the school day
